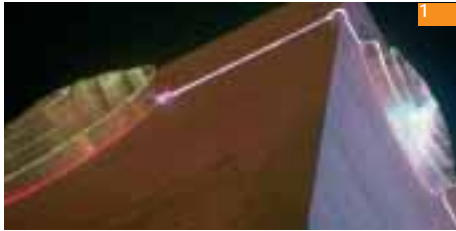
## People make places...
